With a suitcase full of sewing-things, materials for the workshops and a lot of enthusiasm, I travelled in July to Dodoma, Tanzania

Arrived in Dodoma I had a very warm welcome and immediately received a guided tour on 'our piece' of ground. At this miment it is uncultivated with here and there a little bush. However, very soon there will be started with building a sewing-factory for WanaZiwi!!

The 7 women stopped allI there pursuits and wanted to start immediately with the workshops. After a workshop on the project and one on financial

management, we started brainstorming

about products we could produce and about selling possibilities. The women are exceedingly enthusaist and operate for the full 100%!

When I was back in the Netherlands I received the opportunity to go again to Tanzania in September 2010, this time for an internship for my studies.
